Double Deck Blackjack Rules

- 1. The dealer must hit on soft 17 or less.
- 2. A winner is when the player has a higher total than the Dealer. Bets are paid at 1 to 1 odds.
 - a. If a player has the same total as the Dealer, this is a push.
 - b. If a player has a lower total than the Dealer does, the player loses the wager.
- 3. Blackjack pays 1½ times your bet.
- 4. Double down on first 2 cards only, indicate double down by exposing cards to dealer in front of betting circle.
- 5. Any pair may be split up to 4 hands. Exception: Aces may be split only once and receive one card each.
- 6. Double after split is not permitted.
- 7. You may bet insurance on a dealer's Ace, up to one-half your original bet. Insurance pays 2 to 1.
- 8. Please give clear hand signals for hit/stand decisions. Player must scratch cards on layout in back of betting circle, to indicate the desire for another card.
- 9. Any time players first two cards and hit cards total 22 or over, player must expose all cards to dealer. To stand player must tuck corner of first 2 cards dealt under their bet.
- 10. There is no mid shoe entry.
