

Emperor's Challenge Pai Gow Poker Rules

- 1. Emperor's Challenge Pai Gow Poker is identical to Pai Gow Poker with the exception of the optional Pai Gow Insurance, the Emperor's Treasure (with Envy Bonus) and the Bonus Jackpot.
- 2. All regular Pai Gow Poker rules will be followed with the addition of the following options.
- 3. Pai Gow Insurance The player wins the Pai Gow Insurance wager if the seven cards in their hand is a Pai Gow. Only the highest qualifying hand is paid. Paytables will be posted at the gaming table.
- 4. Emperor's Treasure The Player wins the Emperor's Treasure wager if the seven cards in their hand have achieved the pre-determined triggering event according to the paytable posted at the gaming table.
- 5. Envy Bonus When a player wagers \$5.00 or more on the Emperor's Treasure, they may qualify for the Envy Bonus. All qualifying Envy Bonus wagers receive the Envy Bonus prize excluding the player who had the hand containing the winning triggering event. If a player is playing more than one hand of cards, one of their hands may be used as the winning triggering event for the other.
- 6. Bonus Jackpot This is an optional \$1.00 wager. The player wins if their seven card hand has achieved a pre-determined triggering event displayed on the table.
 - a. Bonus Jackpot prizes are paid by the casino and are not components of any progressive prize contest. Player wagers do not accrue to any guaranteed player fund. If the Bonus Jackpot is discontinued or modified the players will be notified through a revised posting on the table.

7. Table Games management has the option of offering, various Gambling Promotions these promotions may or may not be offered. During the times they are available management will post the payouts and the applicable rules. Player must be wagering a \$1.00 Bonus Jackpot Wager and a minimum of \$5.00 Emperor's Treasure wager to qualify for the Gambling Promotions.

- 8. Emperor's Treasure Envy Bonus Bonus Jackpot Paytable
 - a. Paytables will be posted on the gaming table.

9. Wagers

- a. The primary Pai Gow Poker wager is required and must be within the minimum and maximum limits posted at the table.
- b. At the player's option, additional wagers on the Emperor's Treasure and/or Pai Gow Insurance bets may be made. These optional wagers must be within the minimum and maximum limits posted at the gaming table. Any player betting \$5 or more on the Bonus Wager is automatically entered in the Envy Bonus.
- c. The optional Emperor's Treasure and/or Pai Gow Insurance wagers may be larger than the Pai Gow Poker wager. Before cards are dealt, the dealer will place the marker in front of all bonus betting circles with qualifying bets for the Envy Bonus (\$5 of more).
- d. Players may also place an optional \$1 Bonus Jackpot wager.

10. Aggregate Payoffs

- a. \$20,000 is the maximum aggregate payoff, exclusive of the Envy Bonus and Bonus Jackpot payouts. In the event of multiple winners, the maximum will be divided between all players based on their winning hand.
- 11. Players will be notified of any changes to pay tables or waging options through a revised posting at the table.
- 12. Side betting between and amongst players, with or against the house is prohibited.
