## **High Card Flush Rules**

- 1. High Card Flush features a head to head play against the Dealer with two optional bonus bets. The game is dealt using a standard 52 card deck. The Players and the Dealer each receive 7 cards. The object of the game is to have more cards of the same suit (a Flush) than the Dealer, or a higher ranking hand with the same number of cards regardless of the suit.
- 2. The following wagers may be placed in the game of High Card Flush:
  - a. Ante Wager A player may compete solely against the Dealer by placing an Ante Wager and then placing a Raise Wager in 1, 2, or 3 times the amount of the Ante Wager, depending on the number of the cards in the flush.
  - b. Flush Bonus Wager In addition to the Ante wager a player may place an optional Flush Bonus Wager.
  - c. Straight Flush Bonus Wager In addition to the Ante wager a player may place an optional Straight Flush Bonus wager. The following conditions apply:
    - i. The Ante, Flush, and Straight Flush Wagers do not have to be the same amount.
    - ii. The player must make a Raise Wager or they will forfeit the Ante Wager.
  - d. Bonus Jackpot Wager- The Bonus Jackpot wager, if made, is a \$1.00 wager. The player wins this optional wager if their seven card hand has achieved a predetermined triggering event displayed at the table.
    - i. "Bonus Jackpot prizes are paid by the casino and are not components of any progressive prize contest. Player wagers do not accrue to any guaranteed player fund. If the Bonus Jackpot is discontinued or modified the players will be notified through a revised posting on the table."
- 3. Wagers must be within the minimum and maximum limits posted at the table.
- 4. Only players who are seated at a High Card Flush table may wager at the game. Once a player has placed a wager and received cards, that player will remain seated until the completion of the round of play.
- 5. The Dealer must have at least a three card long 9-high flush in order to qualify.

- 6. If the Player's hand ranks higher than the Dealer's hand, the Raise and Ante wagers win and are paid even money.
- 7. If the Player's hand ranks lower than the Dealer's hand, the Raise and Ante wagers lose and are collected.
- 8. If the Player's and the Dealer's hand tie, the Raise and Ante wagers push.
- 9. The Flush Bonus, Straight Flush Bonus and \$1 Bonus Jackpot will be paid according to the paytables posted at the table.
- 10. \$20,000 is the maximum aggregate payoff, exclusive of the Straight Flush Bonus Jackpot payout. In the event of multiple winners, the maximum will be divided between all the players based on their winning hand.
- 11. Side betting between and against players and against the house are prohibited.
